# 2.1.1 Site plan

#### Standard

Is a site plan for the entire premises available?

Site plan should identify major buildings, storage and processing areas and other features that impact on feed safety. Areas for storage of chemicals, medications and any hazardous goods should be shown on the site plan.

### **Purpose**

To ensure site has been designed and laid out to prevent cross-contamination.

#### Reason

A well laid out facility enables the prevention of cross-contamination, ensuring there is less risk to feed safety (including Biosecurity) and therefore the health of animals.

## What is Acceptable?

A "bird's eye view" diagram with key zones and equipment allocated and described.

Key areas to ensure are captured in the diagram are:

- Production areas
  - o Receivals
  - Manufacturing
  - Dispatch
  - Weigh bridge (if applicable)
- Storage areas
  - o Raw Materials
  - o Finished Products
  - S4 storage
  - o Chemicals
  - o Bulk
  - Packaged
- Office areas
- Amenities
- Traffic flow if applicable
- Bait stations (if not included in a separate pest control map)
